

### **Positioned to Serve**

At the heart of what we do is the people we serve. In all operations and in all decisions, the people we serve are the reason we exist and are at the forefront of the decisions we make.

In 2017, Northeast Residence made a significant move. We purchased a new property to house our operations, our adult day care program, and our extended day program. In November we officially moved into our new building at 2539 County Road E East, White Bear Lake, Minnesota. Purchasing this building was a process and in this process we were welcomed by city officials, neighbors and the local businesses. This new building is exciting and provides us with updated facilities with a more central location, more accessibility, expanded space to provide programming and services to the people we serve currently, and to grow our programs for families that are in search of services for their loved ones.

In addition to our move in 2017, we added services to individuals through growth in our respite care program and we were added as the service provider to four women that live in their home in St. Anthony, Minnesota. At the end of 2017, we operated 29 programs in 27 locations.

We remain committed and focused on the services we provide and the opportunity to expand our reach into the communities where we are located.

We are proud to be a service provider, we are proud to be an employer, we are proud to be a partner, and we will continue to place the people we serve at the forefront of all of our operations and decisions.

### BOARD MEMBERS

Dear Friends of Northeast Residence, Inc,

This has been an extraordinary year for Northeast Residence, Inc. There have been many changes and transitions over the 44-year history of our organization. 2017 was another milestone year with one of the most significant changes in our history. Northeast Residence purchased a building in White Bear Lake to house the Northeast Residence office and the Adult Day Care and Extended Day program.

2017 began with the plans to purchase a new corporate office. The new location was purchased and renovated with Administrative staff moving on November 1 followed by the Extended Day Program on November 6th soon after by the Adult Day Care Program. The historic ribbon cutting was on November 15th.

Northeast Residence served over 160 individuals and their families in 2017. The organization has twenty-nine programs and services: Long-term residential care is provided to 100 residents, the two after school extended-day programs merged with the move to the new facility, an adult day program, in-home services, community - based activity programs, and a respite-care program. There are 283 full and part time employees. The Northeast Residence budget is over 10 million dollars. The organization is commended for maintaining an administrative overhead of just 13.1%.

Thank you for your incredible generosity to support the mission and work of Northeast Residence. The individual and corporate partnerships and support of Northeast Residence permitted the organization to provide economic support for special projects including camping, vacation opportunities, supported specialized equipment, employee training and development, employee scholarships, after school programs, and new program development.

Thank you to the dedicated employees who assure the safety and care of each person we serve. The staff are an amazing group who together with those we serve enjoy being a part of the community.




